Healing Hands in Service: Chimanpurwadi Health Camp



On 14 Sept, our team from Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar Vibhag organized a free health camp at Chimanpurwadi. Fourteen students from three colleges participated, and examined 124 patients under the guidance of Dr. Mayur Shinde. They conducted blood pressure and general health checks, and personally learned a lot from this hands-on experience.

Some female students connected with village girls, learning about the social challenges they face. This was carefully planned through several meetings and after the camp, shared lunch and experiences. This camp deepened the student's understanding of community health and service

Three Days For Nation(TDFN) Kinwat(Nanded) - 2025



From 21 to 23 Sept, the Nanded & Latur Vibhag of Sevankur Bharat and Devgiri Kalyan Ashram jointly organized a large and inspiring medical camp at Kinwat, welcoming 157 participants including expert mentors and consultant doctors

Preparations began a month in advance under the guidance of Dr. Jayesh Talankar, Dr. Sarang Mali, Dr. Radheshyam Kulkarni, Dr. Sunil Shinde, Dr. Nitin Patil, and Mr. Aniket Rasal, who ensured smooth planning, logistics, and team coordination

The base camp was set up at Gajanan Maharaj Sansthan. The camp inauguration was conducted by Dr. U. Dhumale, followed by orientation and guidelines for the mission

The initiative went beyond medical treatment — it embraced village outreach, cultural immersion, and rural lifestyle experience. In 10 selected villages, teams conducted patient examinations and engaged meaningfully with local communities to understand their traditions, and cultural heritage Over two days, 1,582 patients were examined — including men, women, and children

The camp concluded with a Samarpan ceremony presided over by Dr. Amar Satpute (Sampark Pramukh – Central Team, Sevankur Bharat) and addressed by Shri Santosh ji Tirmanwar (Vibhag Sanghachalak), who inspired the participants with future service goals


