

Sevankur Bharat proudly hosts the International Medical Outreach Program at Dr. Hedgewar Hospital, Chhatrapati Sambhajinagar, from Dec 8 to 16, 2025, under the leadership of Project In-charge Dr. Prashant Gaikwad

13 international graduate students, aspiring medical professionals, participate across three departments

OBGY (Julia De Sousa, Ariya Chauhan, Diya Kaushal, Marion Jones), Anesthesiology (Jeffrey Pamblanco, Zara Ali, Skyler Juchem, Victoria Puig), and Cardiology (Naika Dumorne, Nicholas Battle, Daniel Pacheco, Skylar Storch), alongside Global Health Intern Margaret Brown

Volunteers engage in structured activities from 10:00 AM to 6:00 PM daily, including patient registration assistance, medication guidance, report distribution, and ward navigation, complemented by one-to-two days of consultant shadowing. Accommodation is provided at Sevankur Bhavan, with vegetarian meals, and adherence to a formal dress code respectful of Indian culture



The itinerary features induction sessions, faculty interactions at R.K. Damani Medical College and DHR, student engagements, a special dinner with department heads, cultural programs, and an Ellora Caves visit. This program enhances participants' profiles for medical admissions and advances Sevankur Bharat's vision for international student exchanges

Three Days for Nation: Bargaon 2025 Success



Sevankur Bharat, Madhya Pradesh Prant, successfully organized “Three Days for Nation – Bargaon 2025” from December 26 to 28, 2025, at the Janjati Kalyan Kendra Mahakosha. A total of 142 medical students participated in this special event, including 87 male and 55 female students. These students came from 18 different medical colleges, comprising 15 MBBS, 2 BAMS, and 1 BDS colleges.

Alongside the students, 16 senior consultant doctors also participated throughout the three-day camp.

Using the Janjati Kalyan Kendra as the base, students stayed in the homes of tribal brothers in 11 nearby villages through 11 groups. During this time, they closely understood their culture, lifestyle, and socio-economic conditions.

On the second day of the event, free medical camps were organized in those same villages, benefiting a total of 824 patients:

- Males: 568, Females: 166 and children: 90


