Devgiri Comes Together: A Collective Reflection

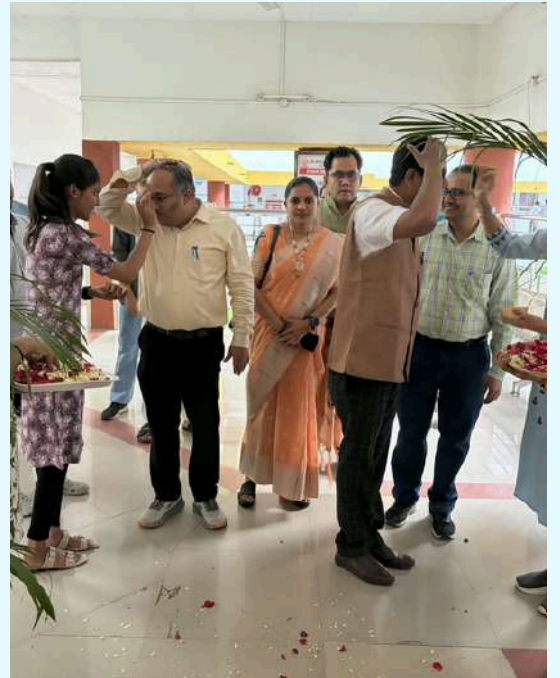

Bhopal – Dr. Hedgewar Hospital Exposure Visit

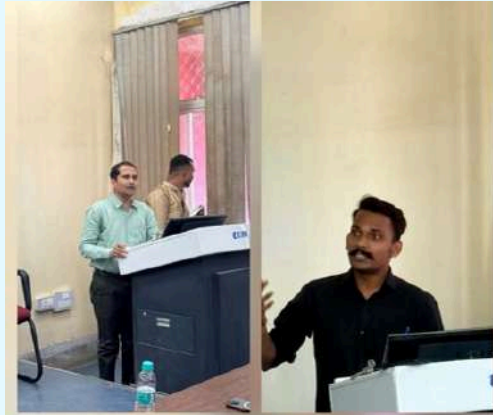

The session was warm and interactive, focusing on student life, service, and ways to stay involved in nation-building activities



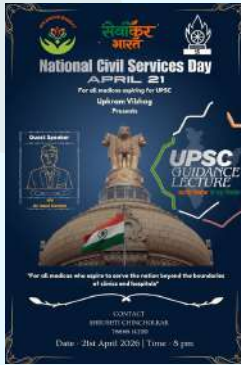
Celebrating the Little Joys
