Organized on 3rd May 2026 at Manthan Auditorium, Chhatrapati Sambhajnagar, the Sevankur Bharat Sneh Milan marked the largest gathering in the organization's history. The event brought together over 1,050 participants, including students, alumni, healthcare professionals, academicians, and well-wishers representing 75 medical colleges across Maharashtra.
