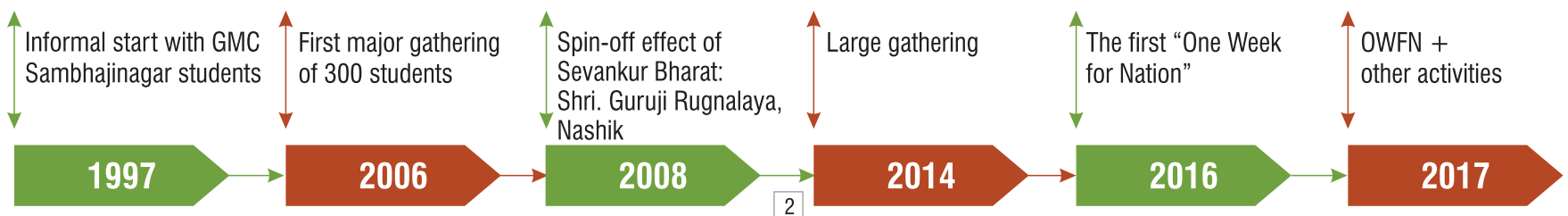

Sevankur Bharat began with informal discussions with undergraduate medical students of Government Medical College, Chh. Sambhajinagar.



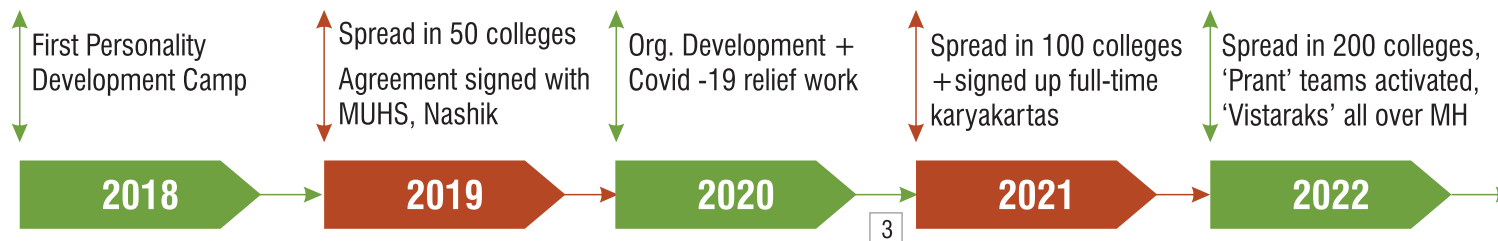

‘One Week for Nation’

With the aim to inspire medical students to work for the society, Sevankur Bharat has been organising “One Week for Nation” programme for the last 5 years.

A large group of student volunteers from across the country, accompanied by senior doctors, travel to one remote tribal area of the country every year to provide medical services free-of-cost.

In FY23, “One Week for Nation” was organised at Sargur, Mysore from 5th-12th May 2022 and Jhabua, Madhya Pradesh from 23 March to 29 March 2023.

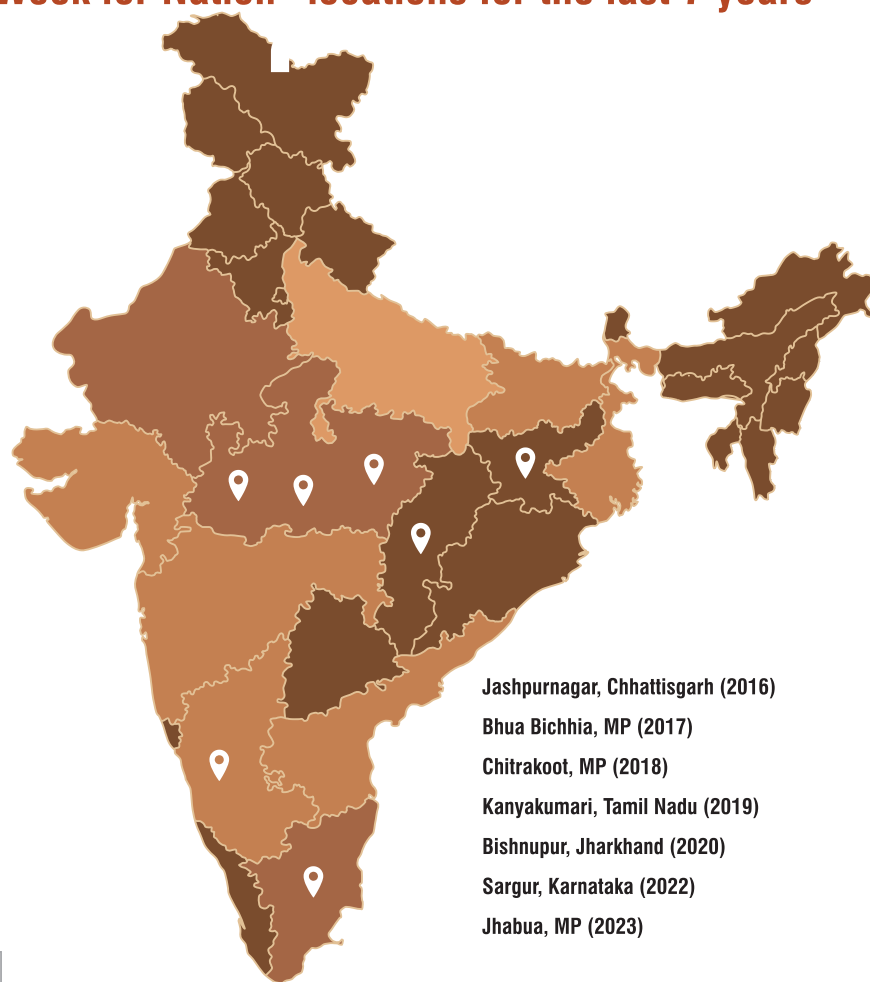

Innovative activities of OWFN

Dibbe me debate

- Conducted in train coaches (dibbe)
- Groups of participants assigned social topics and asked to present views
- Senior doctor manages the discussion
- Helps improve students' communication and listening skills



Survey of Train Passengers

- Students asked to respond to questionnaires based on varied social, environmental, and health related topics
- Students, then, discuss the same topics among themselves and with fellow passengers
- Helps students appreciate others' viewpoints and exposes them to different social issues



Village Activity

- Students brainstorm on awareness and development activities they can undertake in villages apart from primary medical services
- Students have performed cleanliness drives, spread awareness about government projects, demonstrated emergency life saving techniques, etc.
- Helps build a bond between villagers and students
- Helps students innovate and develop togetherness



Group Song Competition (Gat geet spardha)

- Groups of students assigned patriotic songs in different languages
- Asked to listen, practice, and present to all
- Helped develop a friendly atmosphere
- Helped expose students to patriotic songs from different parts of the country



Innovative activities of OWFN

Cultural Night

- Topics under a theme assigned to groups of students 10 days prior to the camp
- Students prepare and perform a play/skit
- Theme (Sargur, Karnataka): “Azadi ka Amrut Mahotsav”
- Theme (Jhabua, MP): “Panchamahabhut”
- Helps the team to explore social topics and work creatively in groups

Value - adding (Bouddhik) Session

- Leading and successful personalities from different fields invited to speak with students
- Sessions conducted on specific topics to pass on wisdom
- Students get a chance to interact one-on-one
- Intended to inspire and motivate students

Poster Competition

- Names of great leaders, kings, queens, warriors, etc. from local state (Karnataka) assigned to groups of students
- Groups are asked to present handmade posters based on the lives and achievements of the leaders
- Helps students learn about local communities



“Halma” Medical Students Embrace an Ancient Tribal Culture

Halma is an ancient cultural practice that the Bhil community of Jhabua follows. It symbolizes the unity of the Bhil people who also rely on the practice to solve all kinds of social and individual problems within the community.

All the OWFN participants enthusiastically embraced Halma, working alongside our tribal brethren to nurture plants and dig trenches for effective water conservation efforts.



Fostering Leadership

- Entire management of the camp and activities is done by student leaders selected based on their previous participation. Each student leader undergoes 1-day training before the camp.
- As a leader, their responsibilities include guiding the team, executing instructions, coordinating activities, and ensuring unity throughout the 'One Week for Nation' event.
