One Week for Nation 2023-24: Dharamwala, Haridwar, Uttarakhand



- Responsibilities given to various team members are also discussed and modified, if necessary.







'Vistarak' Scheme

Speaking at valedictory function of the programme held at Ravindra Natya Grih on Wednesday, the governor said that weeklong stay in forest area serving tribals would help them look at life anew. He also commended institu-
